**INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS
*WSASAS PROCEEDINGS***

Manuscripts that are prepared for publication in the *Proceedings of the Western Section, American Society of Animal Science (vol. 64)* must be submitted at

<http://www.asas.org/membership-services/asas-sections/western-section/meetings>.

A publication charge of \$25 per page must be paid at the time of submission. A Publication Approval Form, Proceedings Author Verification Form, and Invoice must be completed and submitted on or before the submission deadline. Paper restrictions: Use 8.5-inch x 11-inch paper layout with a two-column format and Times New Roman font set at 10 points.

Manuscripts should not exceed four pages. However, one additional page may be added at the end (i.e., after the Literature Cited) for tables and figures only. Style and form should follow the guidelines that are posted on the *Journal of Animal Science* website. Exceeding the page limit, use of incorrect style and form, and(or) excessive typographical and(or) grammatical errors may result in rejection of manuscripts.

Margins: Set left, right and bottom margins at 0.75 inches and the top margin at 0.5 inches.

Page layout: Beginning on the first line of the first page, add the following words centered on the page:

Proceedings, Western Section, American Society of Animal Science

Double space down and add the following information centered on the page:

Vol. 64, 2013

Double space down and add the manuscript title in bold type capital letters and centered on the page.

Double space down and add the author name(s) in bold type and centered on the page; please use authors' initials, not full first names. Single space down and add the location(s) of the author(s) in normal type and centered on the page. The first letter of all words should be capitalized except for prepositions and articles.

Double space down and begin the two-column format of the manuscript. All subsequent pages should begin with the text positioned 0.5 inches from the top.

Columns: Columns of text should be of equal size, spaced 0.3 inches apart, and right and left (full) justified.

Abstract: The left column of the first page should start with the word **ABSTRACT** (all capitals, bold type, flush against the left margin) followed by a colon. The body of the abstract should begin two spaces after the colon. Include up to five keywords on a separate line at the end of the abstract.

Body of the Manuscript: Headings for the Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, and so on, should be centered on the column in bold type with the first letter capitalized. Please refer to the *Journal of Animal Science* style and form for proper use of units of measurement, standard abbreviations, and all other aspects of style and form. Use bold type for the first use of a nonstandard abbreviation.

Tables and Figures: Tables and figures may be incorporated within the column format of the manuscript text or included separately after the Literature Cited. All tables and figures must conform to the *Journal of Animal Science* style and form, with margins set as described above. Remember that tables titles and figures captions should stand alone. Instructions on how to prepare tables and figures can be found on the *Journal of Animal Science* website.

Footnotes: Footnotes should be placed at the bottom of the column under which they first appear.

Uploading papers: Papers must be submitted as either Microsoft Word or Plain Text.

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
