**Andy Roberts**

Andy Roberts obtained a BS in animal science from New Mexico State University, an MS in animal science from the University of Wyoming, and a PhD in animal science (reproductive physiology) from Washington State University in 1988. From 1989 to 1990, Roberts conducted postdoctoral studies at Vanderbilt University School of Medicine with Mike Skinner. Roberts was subsequently employed (1990–2001) as a reproductive physiologist at the USDA, ARS, Meat Animal Research Center, Clay Center, Nebraska. In 2001, Roberts transferred to his current position at the USDA, ARS, Fort Keogh Large Animal and Range Research Laboratory in Miles City, Montana. Currently Roberts serves on the Advising and Coordinating Committee for the Western Section of the American Society of Animal Science (2008–2010), and he recently completed a term (2003–2006) as an associate editor for the *Journal of Animal Science*.
