## Animal Industry Innovation Award

**Name of Award:** The American Society of Animal Science Animal Industry Innovation Award.

**Nature of Award:** A specified monetary award and a plaque.

**Purpose:** To recognize excellence in development of applied technologies that enhances animal production.

**Eligibility for Nomination:** Documented leadership in development of technology to improve management and(or) productivity of livestock.

**Dossier must include the following materials:**

- CV/Biography of the nominee.
- Summary statement (not to exceed 8000 characters and spaces) describing the impact and importance of the nominee's contributions to technology development for the livestock industry.
- Statements of support (max 6) from employers, peers, university partners, and the animal industry and other evidence of nominee's contributions (e.g., patents, scientific publications) collated into a single document.
- Citation for printing and reading (not to exceed 1000 characters and spaces).
- Photo of nominee (photo will only be used in the awards program and will not be visible to the award review committee).
