**Name of Award:** The American Society of Animal Science Animal Physiology and Endocrinology Award.

**Nature of Award:** A plaque and the opportunity to be the Randel Physiology Lecture speaker at the next ASAS Southern Section Meeting.

**Purpose:** To stimulate research excellence in physiology and endocrinology.

**Eligibility for Nomination:**

- Conduct of basic or applied research in physiology and endocrinology with all classes of large and small animals.
- Research work published in the 10 years immediately preceding the year of recognition will be eligible for consideration.

**Dossier must include the following materials:**

- CV/Biography of the nominee.
- Summary statement (not to exceed 8000 characters and spaces) describing the importance of the nominee's contributions to the livestock industry.
- List of the nominee's research publications for the previous 10-year period.
- Citation for printing and reading (not to exceed 1000 characters and spaces).
- Photo of nominee (photo will only be used in the awards program and will not be visible to the award review committee).
