Stormshak Innovations in Reproductive Biology Award

Name of Award: Stormshak Innovations in Reproductive Biology Award

Nature of Award: A plaque.

Purpose: To recognize innovative new methods or discoveries in reproductive biology of livestock.

Eligibility for Nomination:

- Nominee must be an active ASAS member for at least 10 years.
- Nominee shall have either:
 - Through applied research developed new method(s) that lead to improvement of reproductive performance of male or female livestock or
 - Through basic research identified new target tissue responses to hormones or other biologics that underscore a particular stage of male or female reproductive performance.
- Previous winners are not eligible.
- All entries must be submitted electronically by the published abstract deadline. Applicants who have not completed the abstract submission will be removed from consideration for the award.

Dossier must contain the following materials:

- CV/biography of the nominee.
- A separate list of any selected research publications in peer-reviewed journals (not to exceed 10) with brief narratives of their importance/impact on the field of livestock reproduction.
- Summary statement (not to exceed 8000 characters and spaces) describing the importance of the nominee's contribution to the reproductive performance of livestock.
- Citation for printing and reading (not to exceed 1000 characters and spaces).
- Photo of nominee (photo will only be used in the awards program and will not be visible to the award review committee).
