

Elk Camp Games
Group Social Activity - Aspen Snowmass Perinatal Biology
Meeting
Monday August 26, 2019 from 1-4 pm



All meeting attendees are invited and highly encouraged to compete in the inaugural Elk Camp Games at Snowmass Mountain. This friendly team event will have activities for all abilities. You can sign-up for your team at the conference on Saturday and Sunday and more details will be available. Our NIH-USDA Young Investigator Travel Awardees have been pre-seeded to different teams along with pre-selected Team Captains.

What are the Elk Camp Games?

The Games will consist of multiple events that can be completed by one or more individuals on a team. Since each team will need to complete all events, members are encouraged to create teams with diverse skill sets.

- Perinatal Quiz: One completed quiz per team will be scored
- Photo Scavenger Hunt: Find the items on the list and take a picture with your phone
- Corn Hole Tournament: Will be setup at the area near Elk Camp Restaurant
- Disc Golf: 18 hole course at Elk Camp area
 - Note: participants need to rent discs from Snowmass Village before getting on gondola

- Alpine Coaster: Points for number of participants per team and speed (need Lost Forest Base pass)
- Climbing Wall: Points for number of participants and number of climbs (need Lost Forest Base pass)
- Treeline Trial Challenge Ropes Course: Points for team members who complete (need Lost Forest Full pass)
 - *Note: This activity may take 2-3 hours to complete and you must do an orientation on Monday at 12:45 or 1:15pm. If you want to do this activity, please indicate so at Registration by Sunday afternoon (8/25) and we can reserve you a spot in one of the Orientation sessions.*
- Bonus event: Skip the Gondola and save money on the Pass and hike 3.4 miles up the mountain for Bonus Points. Must show proof of hike. Points awarded for each team member.
- Numerous short and long hiking trails are accessible from Elk Camp area (points per mile, per person)

It is easy to participate:

1. At Registration, indicate that you want to participate.
2. Pick-up a Voucher at Registration to buy \$29 Sightseeing Package. You also can purchase a Lost Forest Base or Lost Forest Full Pass depending on if you want to do the Alpine Coaster, Climbing Wall, or Treeline Ropes course events for your Team.
3. Take Voucher to a Ticket Window in Snowmass Village (short walk from Viceroy Hotel) to purchase and activate your Pass. Can be used for multiple days and events (*see other details below*). Please activate your Voucher before Monday available to help prevent long lines on Monday.
4. Sign-up for a Team on Saturday or Sunday.
5. Save 1 of the 3 days of gondola rides on your Pass for Monday afternoon.
6. Save \$10 lunch credit on your Pass for lunch/beverages at Elk Camp Restaurant on Monday Afternoon.
7. On Monday Afternoon, get in line for the Elk Camp Gondola after the morning session ends and ride Elk Camp Gondola up to join the fun. Use your \$10 lunch voucher towards lunch at Elk Camp Restaurant.

Other details:

The Sightseeing Package for \$29 includes many things that you can use while in Snowmass:

- 3 days of gondola and chairlift rides (valid 3 of 7 days) at Sundeck (top of Aspen Mountain) or Elk Camp (top of Elk Camp Gondola at Snowmass). *Please save one day for the group activity on Elk Camp on Monday the 26th.* Feel free to use the other days while you are in Snowmass or visit Aspen.
- \$10 lunch credit at Sundeck (top of Aspen Mountain) or Elk Camp (top of Elk Camp Gondola at Snowmass). Elk Camp serves market-style lunch with grab and go options and full bar. *Please save lunch credit for the group activity on Monday the 26th at Elk Camp.* <https://www.aspensnowmass.com/our-mountains/snowmass/dining/summer>
- \$5 Limelight Lounge credit at Aspen or Snowmass. Use as you wish while in Snowmass. <https://www.gosnowmass.com/dining/limelight-lounge/>
- Maroon Bells Shuttle Bus Tour to trailhead from Aspen Highlands. We suggest you use this Sunday afternoon or Saturday before the meeting. You will need transportation to Aspen-Highlands to catch the shuttle bus to Maroon Bells trailhead. If you do not have a car onsite, there are 4 ways to get to Aspen Highlands:
 - Public Transportation, free from Snowmass Village to Aspen Highlands (requires 2 buses)
 - High Mountain Taxi - prebook multiple minivan taxis - hmtaxi.com
 - Colorado Mountain Express - book a 15 passenger van or larger bus - cmex.com
 - Ask around to find other attendees with cars willing to take people
- 20% off bike rentals at Four Mountain Sports***
- 20% off Intro to Downhill and Downhill Skills Clinic

You can use your Voucher to purchase upgraded passes to use at Lost Forest for the Games or your leisure

- Lost Forest Base for \$47 includes
 - All the above in Sightseeing Pass, plus:
 - Alpine coaster
 - Climbing Wall
- Lost Forest Full for \$71 includes
 - All the above, plus:
 - Treeline Challenge Ropes course
